Dear Parishioners

It was good to see so many of you at our Christmas Services

I wonder how many of you picked up that we are doing something special in our normal services this year. I did mention it last letter. We are calling it 2020 Vision (in the opticians' sense - 20/20 - seeing clearly). We are looking at the Bible from beginning to end and seeing how it all consistently points to Jesus. Sometimes it will be thematic and sometimes consecutive but I am keen that we should all understand the story of God in one big sweep rather than just tiny segments that can be hard to piece together. We are also holding monthly sessions to discuss some of the topics where I hope we can explore some of the tricky questions of faith.

What have we looked at so far? We have seen that, according to the Hebrew Scriptures, humans were made in the image of God. We don't look like him yet we are able to know right from wrong and to love one another. Most importantly we have been blessed by God to be fruitful and also to reign with him over the earth. That means that we have a responsibility for his creation which echoes a lot of the eco news that permeates our media at the moment. But humans chose to listen to and trust a tempter rather than God and that was the beginning of the earth's suffering. If you are interested in following this, you can find the sermons on the website and you are very welcome to join us at any of the services across the benefice.

Life is full of choices. How do you weigh the consequences before making them? Who do you trust to advise you? Have you thought of asking God to help you, especially when it is important? I am happy to come and pray for anyone who seeks God's wisdom. Please do contact me.

Finally, I would like to point you towards what we have planned in the benefice for Lent. We will be having weekly lunches for the community across the Church around the Cliffe on Thursdays and there will also be a weekly course based on the brilliant film "The Way" about a pilgrimage. And don't forget our Forget-menot Tea at Cafe Eleven on Thursday 19th March.
