Dear Parishioners

I am writing this early in the morning. The sun is shining, the birds are singing and there is colour everywhere I look. There are many - as the old song from Ian Drury and the Blockheads put it - *reasons* to be cheerful.

Yet today is also Good Friday. We have been publicly reminded of that this week with the extraordinary picture from Notre Dame of the cross, so visible through the smoke and debris. What Jesus did for us through his crucifixion lasts forever - we can receive forgiveness and our guilt and shame can be taken away as we turn to him. But it also works the other way. It would seem that, as yet, there is no-one to blame for the outbreak of fire at Notre Dame but I expect someone will need to be forgiven. Jesus forgave his captors and executioners on the cross and asks us to forgive too. It is so hard to do that sometimes but it makes such a difference to our lives if we do. It is a choice which God can help us with.

And that is the good news of the resurrection. It gives us hope when our lives do not seem to have many reasons to be cheerful. Jesus defeated death and is alive.

If you are having difficulty forgiving someone and would like me to pray with you, please get in contact. Or we will soon be starting to offer Healing Prayer once a month, on a Thursday, after Morning Prayer, and you might want to come along then. More details to follow.

Finally, do look on our website if you are in need of a comforting word as there is always a Bible Verse there.

May I take this opportunity of wishing you a Happy Easter, even if it has passed by the time you read this newssheet.
